**RE: GROUNDS OF OBJECTION OF THE ELECTION OF THE VENERABLE
FRANCIS FRANK KAULANDA AS BISHOP OF LAKE MALAWI**

I have just come across information that my name has been written on the list of Objectors of the Election of Venerable Francis Kalunda as Bishop of Diocese of Lake Malawi.

I would like to refute in the strongest terms my alleged involvement in submission of the Grounds of Objection of the Election of Ven. Kaulanda as Bishop of Lake Malawi. I want to distance myself from the group and I am not party to it.
